Dear Ms. Watkiss:

At its meeting on Wednesday, October 24, 2012 the Commission considered the attached report entitled "Downtown Rapid Transit Expansion Study (DTRES) Phase 1 Strategic Plan".

The Commission adopted the recommendations in the staff report, and approved the following motions:

1. That future transit expansion plans consider a DRL east of Yonge as a priority, and that study be commenced on the merits of eventually extending the line along the Don Mills corridor to the proposed terminal at Don Mills and Eglinton.
2. That the TTC write a letter, on behalf of the Commission, to the leaders of the Federal Conservative, Liberal, Green and New Democratic Party requesting their plans to meet future public transit ridership demand in the city's downtown core.
3. That the TTC write a letter on behalf of the Commission to the leaders of the Provincial Conservative, Liberal, Green and New Democratic Party requesting their plans to meet future public transit ridership demand in the city's downtown core.
4. That the TTC make the responses publicly available.
5. Request the City Clerk to forward this report, along with the Master Agreement with Metrolinx and Infrastructure Ontario, to the October City Council Meeting.
