RE: City of Toronto Draft Zoning By-law 25 Tanglers Road City of Toronto (North York District)

Weston Consulting is the planning consultant for Lukofsky Holdings Limited, the owner of the property municipally known 25 Tangiers Road (herein referred to as the "subject property"). The subject property is located on the east side of Tangiers Road south of Finch Avenue in the vicinity of the Keel/Finch interchange and subway station currently under construction.
