Re: Official Plan –Municipal Comprehensive Review – Draft Policies and Designations for Employment

Woodbine Entertainment Group ("Woodbine") is the owner of the property known municipally as 555 Rexdale Boulevard (the "Property") upon which Woodbine has operated a racetrack and associated stables since 1956 and, since March 2000, the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation has operated slot machines at the Property.

We are writing to you concerning the City's proposed draft Official Plan Employment Policies as they apply to the Property. Our solicitors, Fasken Martineau DuMoulin LLP, have previously corresponded with the City by letters dated November 12, 2012 and December 11, 2012 with respect to these draft Policies and certain concerns that Woodbine has with respect to the Policies as they apply to the Property.

We are writing to you at this time to confirm that Woodbine continues to have some concerns with the proposed Employment Policies as they apply to the Property. We are working to address and resolve those concerns with the City's Planning Staff.


