The details of the proposed developments were recently brought to my attention. I live on Argyle St. just east of these proposed sites. These locations are currently designated as employment areas. I would like to see these locations developed with employment being the prime focus. Building a mini Liberty Village with a grocery store should not be considered employment. I would like to see a proportional ratio of residential to employment. Toronto already has a surplus of condos with Starbucks and dry cleaners at the ground level.
