PG29.4: Electronic and Illuminated Sign Study Amendments to Chapter 694 of the Municipal Code Planning and Growth Management Committee Meeting December 4, 2013

The Confederation of Resident and Ratepayer Associations in Toronto (CORRA), is writing to support CORRA member associations, resident and ratepayer groups and interested parties' in their request to:

Defer the recommendations to amend Chapter 694 of the Municipal Code for Signs, General, respecting regulations concerning the illumination of signs, signs displaying readograph sign copy, and signs displaying electronic sign copy.

The materials for this agenda item and the amendment to the Municipal Code were posted to the website on November 27 with supplementary materials added on Friday November 29, 2013 for consideration on December 4, 2013.

The request for deferral would allow groups to review the staff report and the accompanying 65-clause by-law amendment (totalling 31 pages) to determine local area and neighbourhood impacts and to comment and provide an informed position.

In addition to the deferral request CORRA, including all resident and ratepayer associations, is asking for Notice of Planning & Growth Management Committee's consideration and decisions and notice/notification of any subsequent consideration/decision of City Council or any other committee that may effect the outcome of the amendments to Chapter 694 of the Municipal Code for Signs.
