The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are deeply saddened to learn of the passing of James M. Tory on August 19, 2013 at the age of 83.

One of Canada's foremost lawyers and corporate directors, Mr. Tory died suddenly while vacationing in Nova Scotia.

Mr. Tory joined the law firm founded by his father, John S.D. Tory, in 1954. His leadership was instrumental to the firm's growth and success, building it into one of Canada's preeminent law firms, Torys LLP.

Mr. Tory brought his experience and expertise to bear on numerous boards, including Inmet Mining Corp., Canadian REIT, Cognos Inc. and Sears Canada Inc. He also served as chairman of the board of the Hospital for Sick Children and of the Hospital for Sick Children Foundation.

Mr. Tory was a close friend and advisor to many in our City and across our country and leaves four children and 13 grandchildren.
