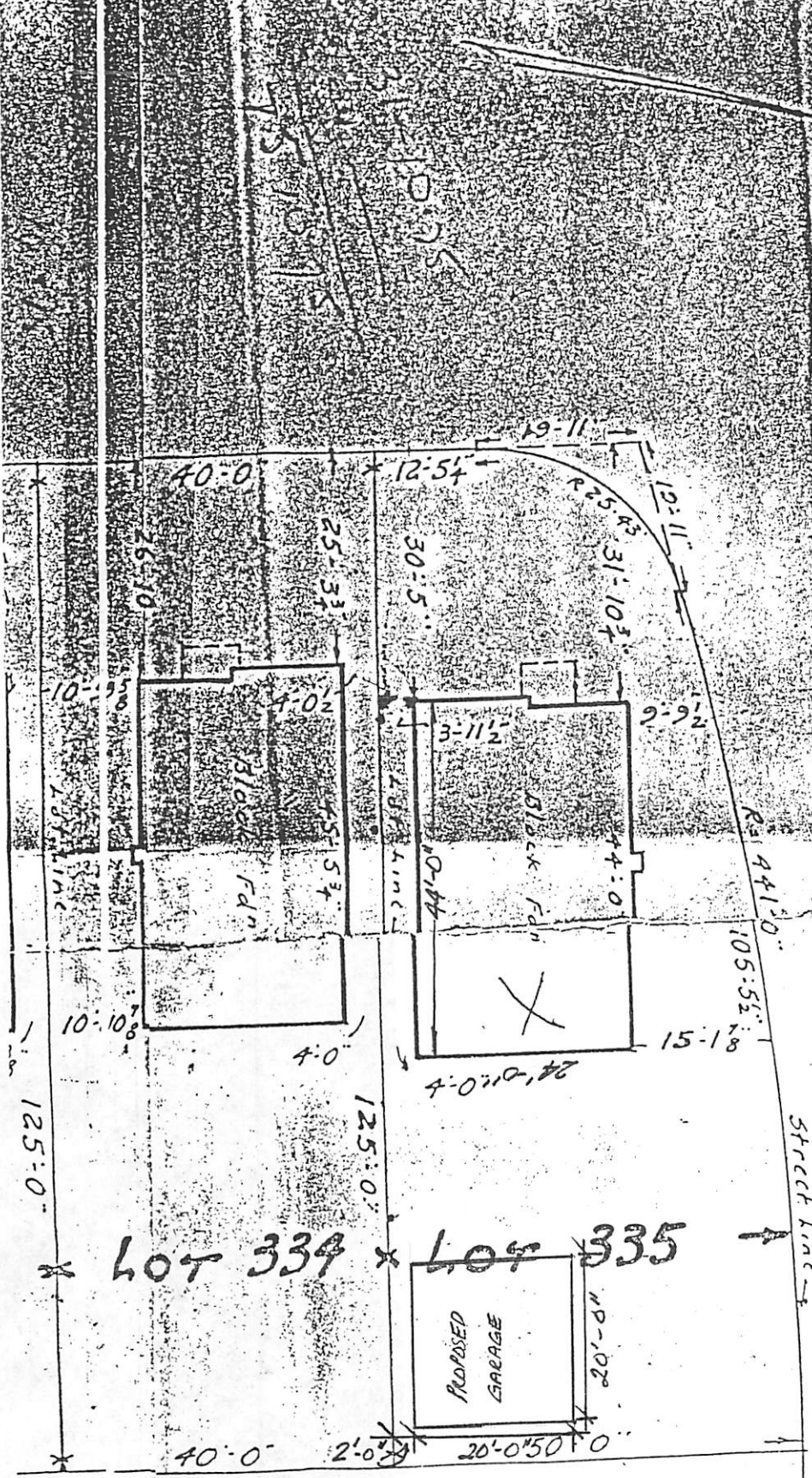

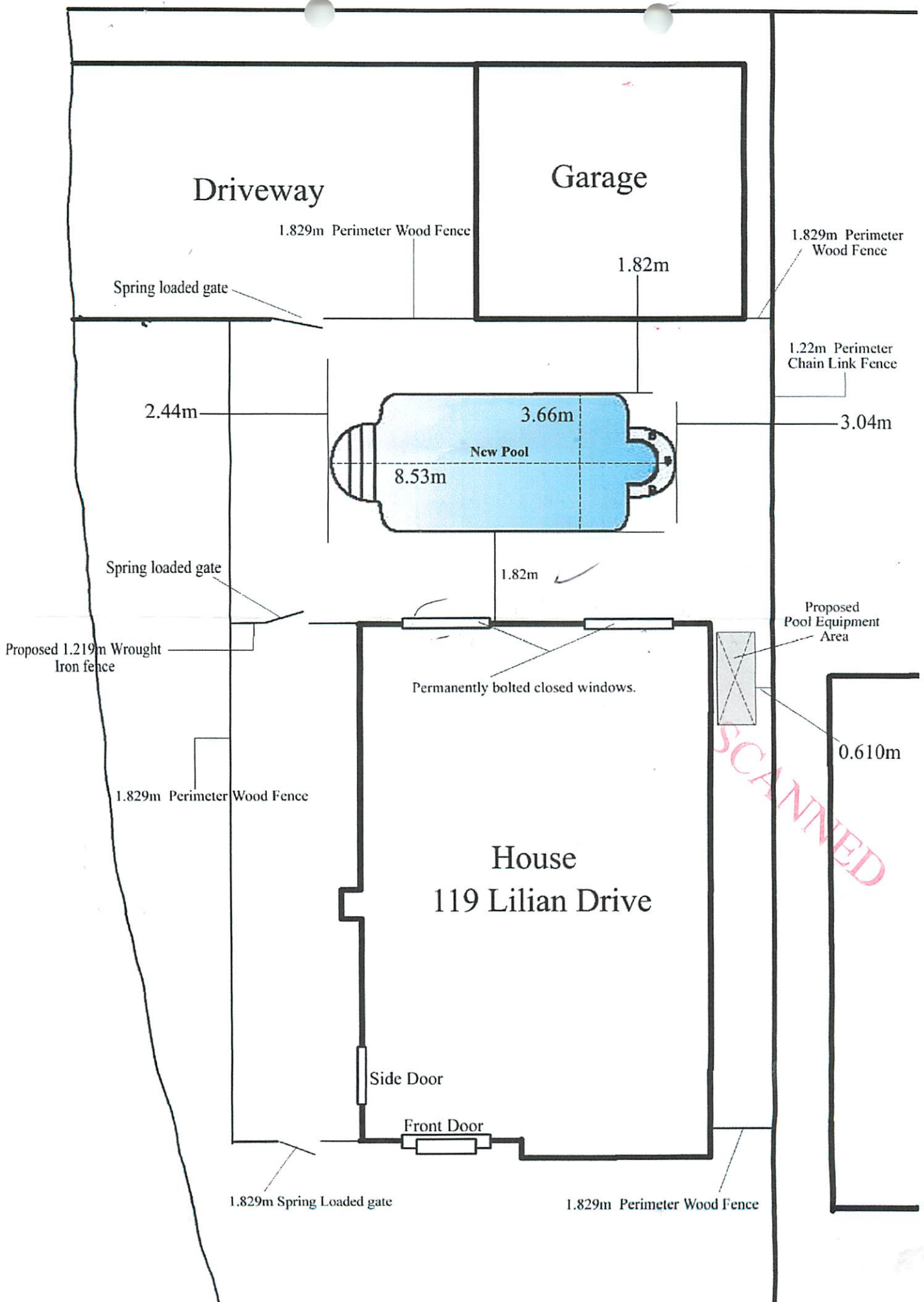
All storm water shall be directed in such a manner that water will not accumulate at or near a building including foundation walls, windows, entrances and walkways.

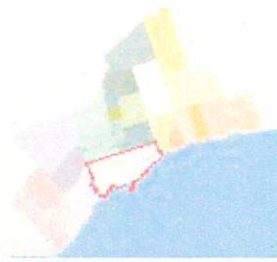
Where the existing grade is altered due to grading, excavation, filling or any other related work, such work shall be undertaken and completed in accordance with good engineering practice to ensure stable conditions, and so as not to adversely affect or damage public or private property.

It is the responsibility of the owner or his agent to confirm that the work will be carried out in conformance with Drainage By-law No. 22932, and that the earth and material from any excavation will be disposed of in the following manner
