BY-LAW No.

To name the proposed public highway north of Gerrard Street East extending westerly from Broadview Avenue as "Bridgepoint Drive".

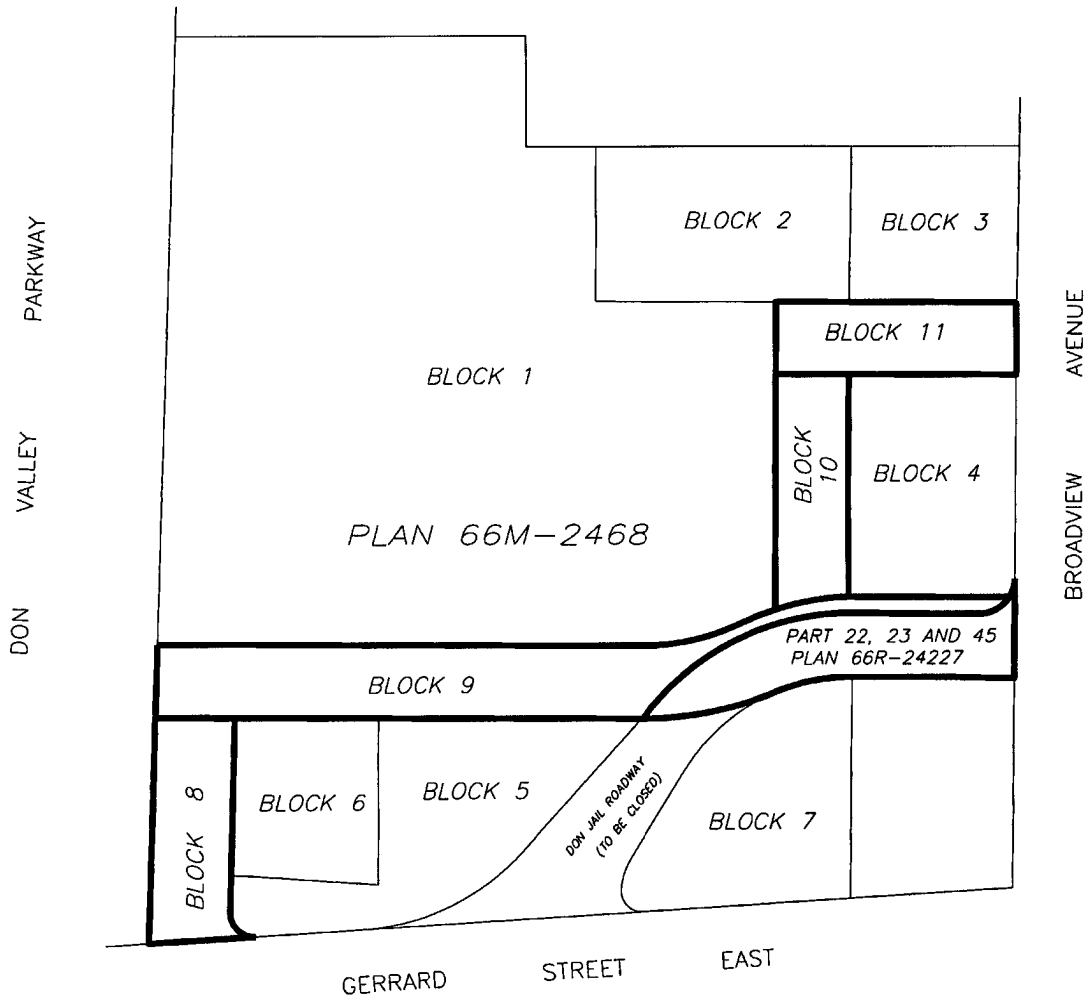
