We are writing you to request that our event Hot Sauce Toronto be considered an event of municipal significance at the next Toronto & East York Community Council meeting on October 17th 2013 for the purpose of a Special Occasion Permit through the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario. Hot Sauce Toronto, will offer 1,000 attendees an opportunity to sample food and house made hot sauces offered 10 different local chefs from restaurants across the city. Our previous 2 events brought together 1,500 Torontonians to enjoy local chefs doing their spin on the popular Japanese noodle dish 'ramen' and have been widely lauded in the local press.

We're hoping that Hot Sauce Toronto will be the latest in a line of several events that will bring together some of the city's best chefs to work with a theme dish and push the boundaries of their skills for the benefit of a host of hungry Torontonians. As with previous events we have held, one of the things we hope to encourage is for guests to sample a wide variety of the high-calibre food being produced in restaurants across the city at an affordable price point and encourage more direct relationship between chefs and their patrons in a low-key friendly environment.

Hot Sauce Toronto will take place from 1pm-8pm on Saturday November 23rd, 2013. It slated to be held at the event space at 99 Sudbury Avenue in Ward 19.

Much like a great meal in a traditional bricks-and-mortar restaurant, the option to enjoy a great beverage alongside your food enhances the experience. So with that mind we're reaching out to local microbreweries and Ontario wineries to provide paired beverages for the gourmet street food that will be served at Hot Sauce Toronto. This is why we would like to apply for the Special Occasion Permit. Non-alcoholic beverages will also be served at the event. We're asking that council review and kindly consider our request. If there are no objections, we would greatly appreciate if it could provide us with any endorsement possible and necessary for our application to the AGCO.
