## 2014 CAPITAL BUDGET BRIEFING NOTE Facilities Management - Old City Hall HVAC Project Update

## Issue/Background:

The purpose of this briefing note is to provide an update on the status of the Old City Hall HVAC project to inform the 2014 Budget process.

## **Key Points:**

The Old City Hall HVAC project will replace new ventilation and air conditioning system throughout the building including associated new head-end equipment, Enwave 'Deep Lake' cooling infrastructure, new ductwork, piping and air conditioning units, new electrical service, new ceilings and shafts, new lighting, new power requirements, and plaster ceiling stabilization/consolidation. Staff provided an update on the status of the Old City Hall HVAC project to the Government Management Committee (GMC) at its meeting on November 21<sup>st</sup>, 2013.

- Approved funding amounts of \$36.9 million are sufficient to complete the project.
- The need to revise the work sequence resulted in a delay in project completion from April 2014 to March 2015.
- Previously approved funding in the amount of \$8.5 million included in the 2014 Capital Budget & 2015 -2023 Capital Plan, and along with carry-forward funding expected from 2013, will be sufficient to complete the project. No additional funding is required for this project.
