Current Restrictions	Proposed Opportunities
<p>Public</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No access to street food on the public right of way outside North York, East York and the downtown core. - Access to food trucks mostly limited to special events and some private property. - Limited diversity in the street food sold from the public right of way – typically hot dogs, sausages, hamburgers and fries. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Potential access to street food on the public right of way in all parts of the City. - Potential access to a greater diversity of street food served from stationary food carts and mobile food trucks on the right of way.
<p>Food Carts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May apply for licences – no limits on the number of licences issued. - May apply for Sidewalk Vending Permits only in North York, East York and parts of downtown. - May not apply for permits in wards 20, 27 and 28, due to the moratorium. - May not apply for vending permits in Etobicoke, York or Scarborough, because legislation of the former municipalities did not allow it. - May not vend in licensed commercial parking lots for more than ten minutes. - Must currently contain cart and supplies within 2.32 square metres of the sidewalk. - Must leave 3.66m of 'passable space' on the sidewalk, and must be 3.66m from the curb. - May not vend in licensed commercial 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May apply for licences – no limits on the number of licences issued. - May apply for Sidewalk Vending Permits in every area of the City of Toronto, except wards 20, 27 and 28. - May vend in licensed commercial parking lots, with permission from the property owner and subject to the zoning by-law. - Vendors who wish to sell a wider menu, and require more equipment and space to do so, will be permitted to apply for 50% more space. - Must leave 2.5m of 'passable space' but may apply for permits to vend at the curbside. - May vend on private property, including

parking lots for more than ten minutes.	licensed commercial parking lots, subject to the zoning by-law.
Food Trucks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May apply for licences – no limits on the number of licences issued. - May only apply for Curb Lane Vending Permits in East York and parts of downtown. - May not apply for permits in wards 20, 27 and 28, due to the moratorium. - May not apply for vending permits in Etobicoke, York or Scarborough, because legislation of the former municipalities did not allow it. - May not vend in licensed commercial parking lots for more than ten minutes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May apply for licences – no limits on the number of licences issued. - May apply for Mobile Food Vending Permits to vend temporarily at curbside parking spaces throughout the City. - May vend on private property, including licensed commercial parking lots, subject to the zoning by-law.
Ice Cream Trucks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May apply for licences – no limits on the number of licences issued. - May obtain Curb Lane Vending Permits, subject to the same restrictions as food trucks in East York and parts of downtown. - May vend in a mobile capacity (for 10 minutes in one spot, 30 minutes on any one street) in Toronto and East York. - May not vend in a mobile capacity in North York because the by-law of the former municipality does not permit ice cream trucks. - May not apply for vending permits in Etobicoke, York or Scarborough, because legislation of the former municipalities did not allow it. - May not vend within 30 metres of a park or ferry dock. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May apply for licences – no limits on the number of licences issued. - May obtain Ice Cream Vending Permits to vend in a mobile capacity (for 30 minutes on any one street) in all areas of the City. - May obtain Mobile Food Vending Permits to vend, like food trucks, temporarily at metered parking spaces throughout the City. - May vend near parks or ferry docks without a specified distance.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May not vend in licensed commercial parking lots for more than ten minutes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May vend on private property, including licensed commercial parking lots, subject to the zoning by-law.
<p>Coffee/Catering Trucks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May apply for licences – no limits on the number of licences issued. - May only apply for Curb Lane Vending Permits in East York and parts of downtown. - May not apply for permits in wards 20, 27 and 28, due to the moratorium. - May not apply for permits in North York, because the by-law of the former municipality does not permit curb lane vending. - May not apply for vending permits in Etobicoke, York or Scarborough, because legislation of the former municipalities did not allow it. - May not vend in licensed commercial parking lots for more than ten minutes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - May apply for licences – no limits on the number of licences issued. - May apply for Mobile Food Vending Permits to vend, like food trucks, temporarily at curb lane parking spaces throughout the City. - May vend in licensed commercial parking lots, with permission from the property owner and subject to the zoning by-law.
