

Parking Prohibitions: Burnett Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

To obtain approval to install No Parking Anytime prohibitions on the south side of Burnett Avenue between Addington Avenue and a point 57 metres west (west limit of 52 Addington Avenue).

The installation of No Parking Anytime prohibitions on the south side of Burnett Avenue, west of Addington Avenue, will address the concerns of the local residents regarding parking issues within the neighbourhood.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services, North York District recommends that North York Community Council:

1. Approve the installation of No Parking Anytime prohibitions on the south side of Burnett Avenue between Addington Avenue and a point 57 metres west.

Financial Impact

All costs associated with the installation of parking prohibitions are included within the Transportation Services' 2014 Operating Budget.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Transportation Services, North York District, was requested by the Ward Councillor on behalf of the residents of Burnett Avenue, to review the feasibility of implementing parking prohibitions on the south side of Burnett Avenue between Addington Avenue and a point 57 metres west.

Residents have indicated that vehicles parked daily by commuters have been restricting the flow of two way traffic.

COMMENTS

Burnett Avenue is classified as a local road with a regulatory speed limit of 40 km/h.

Currently, parking is permitted for maximum periods of three hours on both sides of Burnett Avenue west of Addington Avenue. There are no sidewalks on Burnett Avenue west of Addington Avenue.

Staff have verified that long term daily parking on Burnett Avenue is occurring by commuters. The continuous daily parking on the south side of the road has impacted the flow of two way traffic and the safety of pedestrians.

In view of the above, staff recommends the installation of No Parking Anytime prohibitions on the south side of Burnett Avenue between Addington Avenue and a point 57 metres west.

The Ward Councillor supports the recommendations of this staff report.
