Osterhaut Cabin

This building is recommended for designation for both historical and architectural reasons. This cabin is the oldest building in Scarborough and is believed to have been built by Governor John Graves Simcoe's Queen's Rangers when they initially served the Township in the late 1700's. A typical pioneer home, it is built of logs squared at the corners and piled eight high.
