We have recently been made aware of the Development Permit System and the possibility of this system being implemented in the King-Spadina planning district as a pilot project. Our area has recently experienced an incredible amount of growth with an enormous amount of already approved condo developments. Residents are concerned that we lack the infrastructure and services to accommodate what has already been approved.

In an area that already has so many unanswered questions we are curious to learn why you would choose our community for this experiment. We are also concerned that no public consultations were held in close proximity to the King-Spadina area. Most meetings that concern our area are held at Metro Hall while the closest meeting in proximity you held was at Yonge & Bloor.

We request that you formally include our association (TEDRA) as a stakeholder in any consultation process that involves the King-Spadina area. We also recommend that you hold a local public meeting before you decide to choose the King-Spadina area for a pilot project.
