**PG33.13: Mid-Rise Buildings – Monitoring Update**  
**Planning and Growth Management Committee Meeting No. 33 – May 29, 2014**

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The Mid-Rise Buildings – Monitoring Update report dated April 28, 2014 as part of Planning and Growth Management Committee's agenda PG33.13 to be received as information does not recognize that resident/ratepayer groups have been consulted nor have their concerns been considered in evaluating the "effectiveness" of the Standards that remain under study.

CORRA wrote to the Chief Planner via email correspondence sent April 27, 2014 to follow-up on City Council's Decision of November 2013 for PG27.4 extending the monitoring period of the Mid-Rise Building Performance Standards, as amended and unanimously adopted, that included the following direction:

"City Council direct the Chief Planner and Executive Director, City Planning, to include resident and ratepayer groups and associations as Stakeholders in any consultations anticipated to complete the review of the Mid-Rise Building Performance Standards."

To date the Chief Planner has not responded to our request to have CORRA and other resident/ratepayer groups that are interested or may be impacted by the Mid-Rise Building Performance Standards be included in such consultations. CORRA places the concern on public record.
