I will be away on business for two Ward 37 items for consideration by Scarborough Community Council on April 8, 2014:

**SC31.5 - Request to Grant or Refuse the Application to Demolish Residential Building at 38 Tardree Place With No Building Permits Issued**

I support staff's recommendations to approve the application to demolish the subject residential building at 38 Tardree Place including the conditions outlined by Toronto Buildings.

**SC31.21 - Events of Municipal Significance for Liquor Licensing Purposes**

Diana's Oyster Bar and Grill – 2105 Lawrence Avenue East  
The Wexford Restaurant – 2072 Lawrence Avenue East  
The Loaded Dog – 1921 Lawrence Avenue East
