We are writing you to request that our event "East End Crab Boil part 2" be considered an event of municipal significance at the next Toronto & East York Community Council meeting on June 17th, 2014 for the purpose of a Special Occasion Permit through the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario. "East End Crab Boil part 2", will offer 500 attendees an opportunity to sample food offered by several different local chefs from restaurants across in the Jarvis & Adelaide. Our previous events brought together thousands of Torontonians to enjoy the work of local chefs doing their spin on the popular dishes such as 'ramen' and "dim sum" and have been widely lauded in the local press.

We're hoping that "East End Crab Boil part 2" will be the second of several events that feature food businesses from the local BIA offering food in a convivial outdoor space and encourage locals to try food that's available right outside their front door.
