Bathurst Street Built Form Study

We are writing on behalf of our client, University Health Network ("UHN") the Owner of the Toronto Western Hospital ("Western") and the Krembil Discovery Centre ("KDC") located at Bathurst Street and Nassau Street. It has recently come to the attention of UHN that the City has completed its Bathurst Street Built Form Study and that a Final Report prepared by the City Planning Department will be considered at Toronto East York Community Council on June 17, 2014. (Refer to Item TE33.7).

UHN has been monitoring the Bathurst Street Study and reviewing the publicly available material as it has been released. UHN wishes to express its' concern with respect to the emerging policies that may be included in the upcoming Official Plan Amendment that is scheduled to be considered by Council in August, 2014, implementing to this Study. The Western and KDC are important institutional uses. As such, it is UHN's position that all policy directions should recognize the distinct function of these public facilities and the role that they play both within the community and on a regional scale. It is UHN's view that the Bathurst Street Study and all policy documents related thereto, should acknowledge and support the unique character of the Western and KDC. It is UHN's view that the reports available to date do not recognize the distinct use that these facilitates represent.
