SUMMARY

City Planning is currently assessing the cultural heritage value of Yonge Street between Davenport Avenue and College Street, as part of undertaking a Council authorized heritage conservation district (HCD) study.

The HCD study area designation by-law was adopted by City Council at its February 10 and 11, 2015 and there were a number of site-specific appeals to the Ontario Municipal Board. A prehearing is expected to be scheduled this fall.

This report seeks authority for the City Solicitor to submit a report directly to City Council on July 7, 2015 for directions on this matter.
