### **DECISION HISTORY**

On October 2, 2012, City of Toronto Council adopted Item TE18.19 and included properties between 71 - 95 King Street East on the Inventory of Heritage Properties and stated the Intention to Designate those properties under Part IV, Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.

City Council further directed that if the designations are referred to the CRB, the City Solicitor and appropriate staff are authorized to attend any hearing in support of Council's decision on the designation of the properties.
