# SUMMARY

# RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Solicitor recommends that:

#### **Financial Impact**

## **DECISION HISTORY**

City Planning is currently assessing the cultural heritage value of Yonge Street between Davenport Avenue and College Street, as part of undertaking a Council authorized heritage conservation district (HCD) study.

The first public meeting for the Historic Yonge Street HCD Study was held by the City of Toronto (Heritage Preservation Services) on September 25, 2013. The second community consultation was held by the City on March 26, 2014. A preliminary report entitled "Proceeding to Plan Phase of the Proposed Historic Yonge Street Heritage Conservation District" dated July 3, 2015 was adopted by the Toronto Preservation Board on July 28, 2015. A final report with recommendations is anticipated to be before the Toronto Preservation Board on December 15, 2015 and will subsequently be considered at the first meetings of Toronto and East York Community Council and City Council in 2016.

The HCD study area designation by-law was adopted by City Council at its February 10 and 11, 2015 and there were a number of site-specific appeals to the Ontario Municipal Board. A prehearing has been scheduled for October 30, 2015.
