

Dear Community Council of Toronto and East York –

Hope you're all well! I have a licencing request to put before you that I'd appreciate your time in considering.

Downtown Toronto retailer Tiger of Sweden (located at 56 Ossington Ave) would like to host an event series – tentatively scheduled to take place Saturdays, May 9 and 23, 2015 – the return of their neighbourhood event series from last June.

Wanted a request for a letter indicating the events as ones of “municipal significance” – for the AGCO permit application.

As with last year, the events would run from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. for each date. The goal of the events would be to promote the neighbourhood feel of the street and also drive additional foot traffic to all restaurants, stores and salons in the area.

We're inviting local businesses to set up small pop-ups on Tiger of Sweden's spacious front patio (image pasted below), and would like to be licensed to sell food and drink and offer services and entertainment to guests and locals who will be enjoying the festivities.

Please note that we haven't experienced a high volume of drink consumption at these events, but want to have the option of sampling alcoholic beverages at the event and require the denotation of municipal significance to receive licencing for the patio.
