## RE: Event of Municipal Significance – The Village Summer Festival

The Village Church Wellesley Business Improvement Area is in the process of planning for a special street closure as part of WorldPride 2015 festivities.

The event will require street closure from Friday, June 19, 2015, at 6pm through Monday, June 22, 2015, at 3am. Extended food and beverage patio service will adhere to the following schedule:

Friday, June 19, 2015 6:00pm – 11:00pm\* Saturday, June 20, 2015 11:00am – 11:00pm\* Sunday, June 21, 2015 11:00am – 11:00pm\*

\*Last call for alcohol service on the extended patios will be 10:00pm.

Programmed as a neighbourhood "block party," there will be a single stage located 514 Church Street where all entertainers booked for this event will perform. Entertainment will include female impersonators and other artists. There will be no use of public nudity during any of these performances.

The street closure will extend from the north side of Wood Street at Church Street, to the south side of Wellesley Street at Church Street. In addition, approximately 150 feet of Maitland Street, both east and west of Church Street, and 150 feet of Alexander Street, both east and west of Church Street, will be included in the street closure perimeter.

On behalf of several Licensed Bars, Clubs and Restaurants within The Village BIA's boundaries, the BIA is submitting applications to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.

This AGCO request is with respect to a temporary extension onto the sidewalk and approximately 5' on to the public roadway on Church Street and similar temporary extension on Maitland and Alexander Streets.
