# **2015 OPERATING BUDGET BRIEFING NOTE** Swim to Survive Expansion

#### **Issue:**

• At the February 4<sup>th</sup> Budget Committee meeting, the Budget Committee requested that Parks, Forestry and Recreation (PF&R) report to Budget Committee on the cost to implement the balance of the Swim to Survive program and a summary of the program, number of participants, participating school pools and schools involved in the program in 2014.

## **Background:**

- Swim to Survive program is a free program that PFR has delivered in partnership with the
  Lifesavings Society and local school boards. The expansion of the program was approved by
  Council as a part of the Recreation Service Plan and the first phase of funding was approved
  in the 2014 Operating Budget process. The program delivers basic in-water skills to prevent
  drowning with three in-water skill introduction classes which focus on the ROLL, TREAD,
  SWIM skill sequence.
- The goal of the program is to ensure that every grade four student in the City of Toronto learns basic swim survival skills. The goal of the program expansion is to provide Swim to Survive to 22,000 students by 2016 which is 100% of Grade 4 students.

### **Key Points:**

- The Swim to Survive program was to be implemented over 3 years (2014 2016).
- The 2014 Council Approved Operating Budget for PF&R included funding of \$0.125 million to begin the expansion of the Swim to Survive program. The annualized portion of the 2014 approved funding in the amount of \$0.092 million has been included in the 2015 Staff Recommended Operating Budget.
- The additional annual funding requirement of \$0.488 million in 2015 and \$0.340 million in 2016 to complete the implementation of the Swim to Survive program would bring the program expansion cost to \$1.045 million. The additional funding to expand the Swim to Survive program beyond 2014 levels is not included in the 2015 Staff Recommended Operating Budget.
- There is funding available through the Royal Lifesaving Society for a portion of the Swim to Survive program for base service levels. The funding has been declined in recent years and cannot be confirmed for future years. The additional funding requests for the Swim to Survive expansions in 2015 and 2016 do not anticipate any additional Royal Lifesaving Society grants as they cannot be confirmed.

- The grant from the Royal Lifesaving Society was funded by the Ontario Ministry of Education and the Stephanie Gates Foundation.
- Approval of future year funding would also result in the addition of 9.0 FTEs to PF&R's staff complement to provide program supervision, coordination and instruction, resulting in total complement of 11.0 FTEs for the Swim to Survive program as outlined in the table below.
- The increase in FTE complement correlates with the service level increase based on the number of participants and program hours as outlined in table #2.

- Community Recreation's 2015 Staff Recommended Operating Budget includes sufficient funding to support the existing Swim to Survive program delivery to approximately 7,300 students through the TDSB and TCDSB.
- The Swim to Survive service level target of 22,000 participants annually was approved by Council in the Recreation Service Plan. This consists of approximately 50% of grade four students in both the TDSB and TCDSB by the end of 2015 and 100% of all grade 4 students participating in the program by the end of 2016 (see table below).

Program support to the TDSB includes coordination of program locations, provision of program materials and support of the grant application. \*\* 2015 and 2016 Service levels based on Council approval for the Expansion of Swim to Survive.

- A complete list of participating TCDSB schools is outlined in Appendix A.
- The TDSB delivers the Swim to Survive program to approximately 3,000 students at 18 of its school pools with the current support of a Royal Lifesaving Society grant.
- In 2014, the City supported the TDSB in its direct delivery of the program through the coordination of program locations, provision of program materials and grant application support through the Royal Lifesaving Society which off-sets the costs of instruction, transportation and any applicable facility rentals.
- The program is best delivered through the school system where access for all children can be scheduled as part of the school program with no additional registration requirements.
- Staff have been working with both school boards to enhance partnerships that will remove barriers to full enrolment including pool availability, transportation, scheduling and coordination of the program, in an effort to reach 100% participation by 2016 year-end.
- The Swim to Survive program is delivered primarily through City owned facilities. As per the Pool Agreement, the City does not have access to TDSB pools during day time hours, Monday through Friday, during the school year.
- If the additional funding is provided, the expansion of the Swim to Survive program would be phased in over 2015 with full implementation of the program in 2016.

#### **Ouestions & Answers:**

- How was the funding approved in the 2014 Operating Budget used for the Swim to Survive program?
  - ➤ The 2014 Council Approved Operating Budget for PF&R includes funding of \$0.125 million to coordinate the expansion of the Swim to Survive program. In addition, the annualized portion of \$0.092 million has been included in the 2015 Recommended Operating Budget.
  - ➤ Staff worked with the TCDSB to deliver the Swim to Survive program to 4,300 students in grade four, an approximate increase of 40% from 2013. In addition, staff worked with the TDSB to support the direct delivery of the program to 3,000 students in grade four at City and TDSB pools for a total of 7,300 annually.
  - > Staff continue to work with both school boards to enhance partnerships and remove barriers including pool availability, transportation, scheduling and coordination of the program in an effort to reach 100% participation by 2016 year-end.
- What is the annual financial impact to fully implement the Swim to Survive Expansion?
  - The 2014 Council Approved Operating Budget for PF&R includes funding of \$0.125 million to begin the expansion of the Swim to Survive program. In addition, the annualized portion of \$0.092 million has been included in the 2015 Recommended Operating Budget. Additional funding of \$0.828 million is required to fully implement the Swim to Survive expansion, bringing the total to \$1.045 million.
- What is the impact on the program if funding is not approved?
  - ➤ The expansion of the program cannot continue beyond current services levels of approximately 7,300 students annually.
