Executive Meeting No. 3 – March 2nd, 2015

CORRA, the Confederation of Resident and Ratepayer Associations in Toronto, is writing to confirm our position as deputed on February 2nd, 2015:

- 1. To ensure the City 2015 planning budget allocates money towards HCDs and local area policies and zoning;
- 2. To ensure there is money in the budget for additional resources that include planning staff to make these local planning needs a priority; and
- 3. That discretionary legal services be continued and they involve both the community and local Councillor in requesting the City solicitor to attend alcohol and licensing hearings or OMB hearings.

CORRA is holding a meeting of members this weekend and we will provide a more refined position on the City's 2015 Budget and its amendments as brought forward on February 20, 2015.
