I am encouraged by the SmartTrack status update report, specifically with the initial information on the Western Corridor Feasibility Review.

I look forward to the refined alignments that will be presented to Council in a final report that will include: Corridor 2B – West of Highway 409 and Corridor 2C – East of Highway 427 options.

These alignments that would continue service along the existing GO Kitchener corridor have the potential to bring stronger, accessible transit for residents in North Etobicoke.
