Subject: Request to support change to AGCO Liquor Licence for Black Oak Brewery,
75 Horner Ave.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Etobicoke York Community Council support the application from Black Oak Brewery, 75 Horner Avenue, to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario to change their licence from a Manufacturer's Liquor License to a Manufacturer's Limited Liquor Licence, and the City Clerk be directed to advise the AGCO accordingly.

SUMMARY:

I have received a request from Black Oak Brewery, 75 Horner Ave., to support their application to the AGCO to obtain a Manufacturer's Limited Liquor Licence. Currently, with a Manufacturer's Liquor Licence, the brewery is open until 5:00pm on weekdays and 3:00pm on Saturday, and only permitted to serve 3-4 oz free samples. With the amended licence, the brewery can extend their hours until 9:00pm, and sell and serve 12 oz servings of their beer to patrons.
