BY-LAW No. -2015

**To permanently close a portion of Islington Avenue abutting
the rail corridor north of 2180 Islington Avenue**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of Islington Avenue abutting the rail corridor north of 2180 Islington Avenue, designated as Part 19 on Reference Plan 66R-26940 be permanently closed as a public highway; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the above-referenced portion of Islington Avenue was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Etobicoke and York Community Council at its meeting held on February 18, 2015;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. A portion Islington Avenue abutting the rail corridor north of 2180 Islington Avenue, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

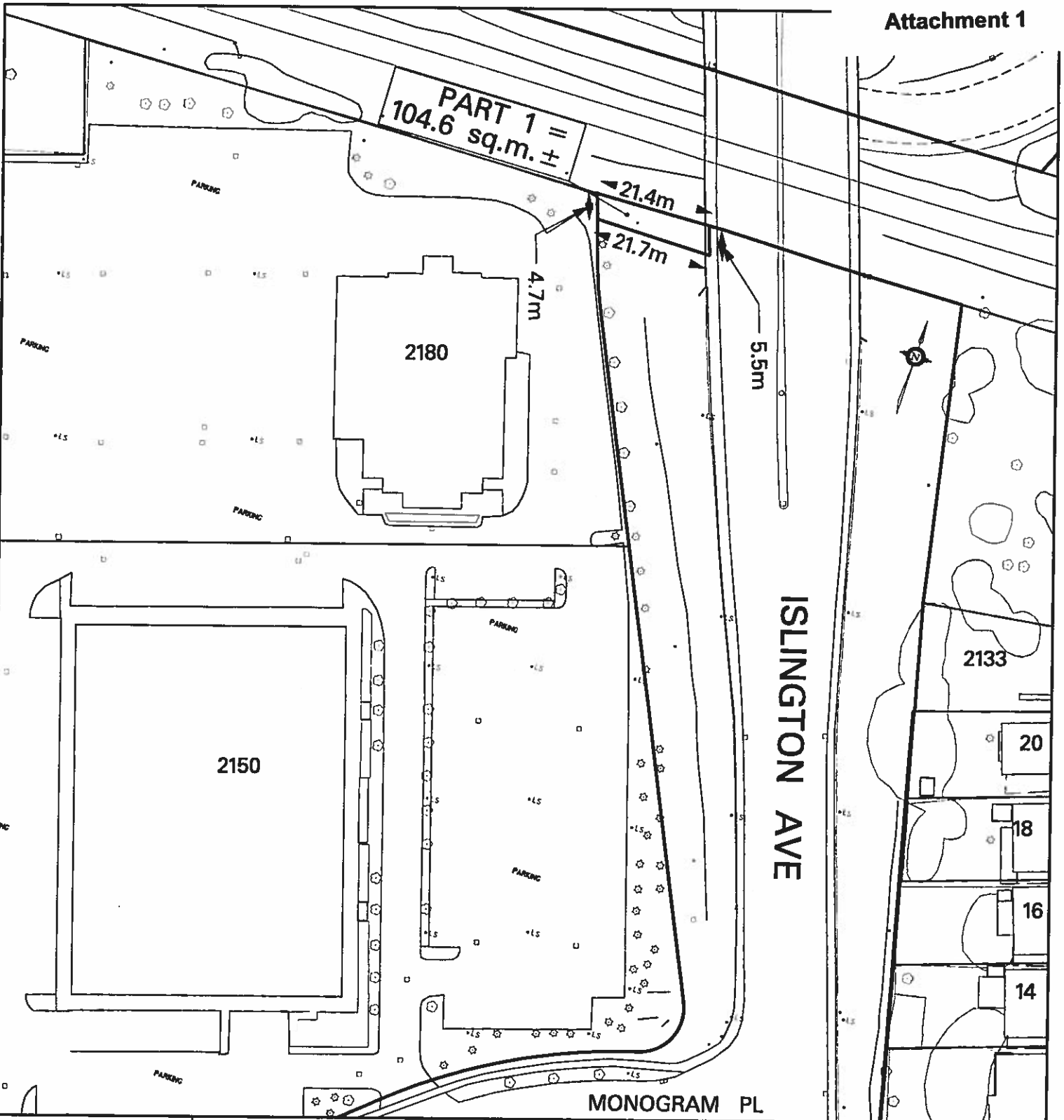
