SUMMARY

On February 10 and 11, 2015, City Council designated a heritage conservation district study by adopting By-law No. 277-2015 "To designate Historic Yonge Street between Davenport Road and College Street as a Heritage Conservation District Study Area". Further direction from City Council is required.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Solicitor recommends that:

- 1. Council adopt the confidential recommendations to staff in Attachment 1; and
- 2. Council authorize the public release of the recommendations in Confidential Attachment 1 and Appendix A and B, if adopted and the balance of Confidential Attachment 1 one remain confidential.

Financial Impact

Adopting this report will have no financial impact beyond what has already been approved in the current year's budget.

DECISION HISTORY

At its meeting on October 2, 3 and 4, 2012, City Council authorized Historic Yonge Street for a Heritage Conservation District Study. The Historic Yonge Street area had been nominated for study as a heritage conservation district through the City's nomination process in January 2012:

On February 10 and 11, 2015 City Council considered Item MM3.38. This was a By-law to designate a heritage conservation district study area pursuant to Section 40.1 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.
