REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report deals with personal matters about identifiable individuals who are being considered for appointment to the Metro Toronto Convention Centre Board of Directors.

SUMMARY

The Facilities and Finance Nominating Panel will interview and recommend two candidates to City Council for appointment to the Metro Toronto Convention Centre Board of Directors.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. The Facilities and Finance Nominating Panel recommend two candidates for appointment to the Metro Toronto Convention Centre Board, at pleasure of Council, for a term of office ending on November 30, 2018, and until successors are appointed.

2. City Council direct that the confidential information contained in Confidential Attachments 1, 2 and 3 remain confidential in their entirety as they relate to personal matters about identifiable individuals being considered for appointment to the Metro Toronto Convention Centre Board of Directors.

COMMENTS

Tourism Toronto appointment to be considered at a later date

The City of Toronto has three seats on the Metro Toronto Convention Centre board. Currently, the City's three members on the board include:

- 2 Toronto residents
- the President and Chief Executive Officer of Tourism Toronto

On March 19, 2015, the current CEO of Tourism Toronto, David Whitaker, announced he is leaving Tourism Toronto in the near future to take a new position with a firm in Washington D.C. Tourism Toronto has not yet announced his replacement. Once the new CEO is announced, the Facilities and Finance Nominating Panel can consider the appointment of the Tourism Toronto representative.

Board members' terms will not be staggered

At its August 2014 meeting, City Council approved changes to the Public Appointments Policy to permit the staggering of terms of office for all boards not otherwise prescribed by law so that the terms of half the members expire every two years.

Because the Metro Toronto Convention Centre is an external board governed by separate legislation, the City of Toronto's staggered terms do not apply.

Public release of names of recommended candidates

The names of the recommended candidates will not be publicly reported until the Facilities and Finance Nominating Panel forwards its recommendations to City Council.
