SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend Council Member appointments to the North York Community Preservation Panel.

RECOMMENDATIONS

DECISION HISTORY

City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 103, Heritage, sets out the composition and nomination process for the City's Community Preservation Panels. The North York Community Council is to nominate one to two Members to the Community Preservation Panel for the Community Council area.

Council appointed Members in February 2013 for a term of office ending November 30, 2014 and until successors are appointed. It is now necessary to appoint Members for the new term of Council.
