CORRA, the Confederation of Resident and Ratepayer Associations in Toronto, is writing to ask whether it would be feasible for the City to introduce or re-introduce Committee of Adjustment Public Hearings that start in the afternoon and into the evening as a means to attract more qualified candidates to apply for appointment to the Committee of Adjustment as panel members than having hearings held strictly during the day.
