Dianne:

On behalf of the Canadian Association for Surface Finishing (CASF) I am pleased to confirm that we support the proposal under the *Sewers By-Law, Municipal Code Chapter 681, Section 5 Pollution Prevention Planning* to

- Create a subject pollutant threshold reporting list based on 25% of the sanitary sewers bylaw limits; and
- Zero discharge (0 mg/L) of the five pesticides aldrin/dieldrin, chlordane, DDT, mirex and hexachlorobenzene; plus the removal of these five pesticides off the subject pollutant list because they have been banned in North America and are not manufactured or imported for any use.

CASF appreciates your willingness to offer a reasonable compromise that lessens the current regulatory reporting requirements and we look forward to working collaboratively with you as the proposal moves forward.
