RE: Proposed Creation of a Subject Pollution Threshold Reporting List

I, Mark Scruton, from Viasystems Toronto, Inc. understand that Toronto Water is proposing the creation of a subject pollution threshold reporting list that would apply to all companies required to submit a P2 Plan.

By creating subject pollutant threshold limits, which is the minimum level of a subject pollutant that requires a P2 Plan submission, industries can eliminate reporting on **trace amounts** of subject pollutants that may be present in the effluent discharged from their property. This would be a more effective use of resources for both industry and the City and could allocate resources to more problematic operational issues/concerns.

We are in support of amending the SEWER BY-LAW Chapter 681, Section 5, Pollution Preventing Planning to incorporate the proposed subject pollutant threshold reporting list that represents 25% of the sanitary and combined sewer bylaw limit (Table 1 in the Sewers Bylaw, Municipal Chapter 6814).
