For many years, both Muriel and Laurie served with distinction on the Board of Directors of the Swansea Historical Society. In 2012, Muriel and Laurie both received 20-year Volunteer Service Awards from the Ontario Ministry of Citizenship and Immigration, recognizing their long and dedicated service to our community. Despite life-long constraints resulting from a serious automobile accident in 1949, Muriel participated in countless aspects of community and church life with her loving husband Laurie by her side.

Born two weeks apart, Muriel and Laurie spent their lifetime together, first meeting at Riverdale Collegiate Institute, then marrying in 1943. On September 22, 2013 Muriel and Laurie renewed their marriage vows while celebrating their 70th anniversary together. Sadly, this year Muriel and Laurie passed away within one month of each other, both at age 93.
