After her initial start with the Quakers, Nancy went on to work and volunteer for a wide range of health care, civil and social sector agencies including: La Leche League, the City of Toronto, St Michael's Hospital, St> Joseph's Health Centre, East End Community Health Centre, Riverdale Hospital, Toronto East General Hospital, WoodGreen Community Services, PARC, Stop 103 and Neighbourhood Concepts.

As the president and owner of Neighbourhood Concepts (NCNC), a Toronto based non-profit condo development resource group, Nancy strove to make the dream of home ownership more achievable for a broader range of people. There are many in our City who live in homes and benefit from social programs that Nancy helped develop.
