The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are deeply saddened to learn of the passing of Immacolata Nunziata, mother of Councillor Frances Nunziata, on November 30, 2015.

Born on March 24, 1916, Immacolata Nunziata was a devoted wife, proud mother, loving grandmother, and caring great grandmother who passed away at the age of 99 after living a long and fulfilling life. Born in Italy, Immacolata immigrated to Canada aboard the Vulcania, docking at Pier 21 (Halifax, Nova Scotia) on September 18, 1952. She spent the early years of her new life in Canada in Revelstoke, British Columbia with her 7 children and late husband, Dominic Nunziata. In 1963, the family moved to Toronto where Immacolata happily lived out the rest of her life.

Immacolata is remembered as a strong woman who stretched every dollar and made sacrifices so that her children would not be left wanting. She always put family first and was happiest when surrounded by those who loved her.
