

Parking Regulations – Chine Drive

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report responds to a request from Scarborough Community Council on options for parking on Chine Drive after completion of the roadway reconstruction.

It is recommended that the existing No Parking Anytime regulation on both sides of Chine Drive between Kingston Road and the south end of Chine Drive be retained, posted and enforced.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Scarborough Community Council:

1. Direct staff to post the appropriate No Parking Anytime signs on both sides of Chine Drive from Kingston Road to the south end of Chine Drive to give effect to the regulation currently set out in Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950.

Financial Impact

The financial cost of installing the No Parking Anytime signage on both sides of Chine Drive is approximately \$2,500.00. Funding for the signs has been requested in the Transportation Services 2015 Operating Budget, within Cost Centre TP0397.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

At its meeting of June 18, 2013, Scarborough Community Council directed the Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District, to report back to Scarborough Community Council on options for parking on Chine Drive once the road alteration is constructed. The reconstruction was completed in the fall of 2014. Transportation Services staff have investigated the feasibility of permitting on street parking on this portion of Chine Drive. The road was reconstructed with a curb face accompanied by an interlocking- pavers surface sidewalk on the east side, and a gravel shoulder on the west side, with a typical pavement width of 6.0 metres.

COMMENTS

Several characteristics describe the subject portion of Chine Drive include:

- The land use on Chine Drive is single family dwellings.
- A primary school is located on the east side of Chine Drive at the south end of the street.
- The subject roadway is located south of Kingston Road, east of Midland Avenue, west of Brimley Road. A sidewalk is located on east side of the roadway.
- Chine Drive is a two-lane local road approximately 6.0 metres in width with a posted speed limit of 40 kilometres per hour.
- Chine drive has a traffic volume of approximately 900 vehicles per day and an operating speed of 42 km/h.

The 6.0 metres pavement width precludes the provision of any safe on-street parking. We anticipate the installation of the No Parking Anytime signage will assist in maintaining two- way traffic on Chine Drive.

Chine Drive is classified as a local roadway in the City's approved Road Classification System. As such, the authority to implement any parking regulation has been delegated to Scarborough Community Council.
