Stopping and Parking Prohibitions – Upper Rouge Trail Area

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This staff report concerns the technical amendment of previously adopted by-laws. The proposed amendments to the time period of the stopping regulations on Upper Rouge Trail and on Antelope Drive will make the by-laws consistent with the signs that have already been installed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Scarborough Community Council:

- 1. Rescind the stopping prohibition in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the north side of Antelope Drive, from a point 15 metres west of Savanna Drive to Upper Rouge Trail.
- 2. Prohibit stopping from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the north side of Antelope Drive, from a point 15 metres west of Savanna Drive to Upper Rouge Trail.
- 3. Rescind the stopping prohibition in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the east side of Upper Rouge Trail (north-south leg), from Antelope Drive to a point 15 metres north.

- 4. Prohibit stopping from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the east side of Upper Rouge Trail (north-south leg), from Antelope Drive to a point 15 metres north.
- 5. Rescind the stopping prohibition in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the east and south sides of Upper Rouge Trail (on the north-south and east-west legs, respectively), from a point 45 metres north of Antelope Drive to a point 141 metres further north and then east.
- 6. Prohibit stopping from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday except public holidays, from September 1 of one year to June 30 of the next following year, inclusive, on the east and south sides of Upper Rouge Trail (on the north-south and east-west legs, respectively), from a point 45 metres north of Antelope Drive to a point 141 metres further north and then east.
- Rescind the parking prohibition in effect at all times on the south side of Antelope Drive, from a point 14 metres west of Savanna Drive to a point 109 metres west of Savanna Drive.
- 8. Prohibit parking at all times on the south side of Antelope Drive, from a point 109 metres west of Savanna Drive to a point 14 metres further west.

Financial Impact

There is no financial cost associated with the recommendations of this report. The stopping and parking regulation signs have already been installed.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Following public meetings arranged by Councillor Raymond Cho's office with representatives from Alvin Curling Public School and area residents, Transportation Services staff have reviewed the parking issues on Upper Rouge Trail and on Antelope Drive to determine the feasibility of accommodating short term parking in the vicinity of the school. Similarly, as a means to better control traffic in front of this school, temporal turn and through restrictions were reviewed at Antelope Drive and Savanna Drive.

The previously recommended parking, stopping, and turn regulations were adopted by Scarborough Community Council at its meeting on June 17, 2014 (SC33.12). However, the current changes are intended to bring the regulations into conformance with the signs that the community has agreed to and have already been installed.

COMMENTS

The following characteristics describe Upper Rouge Trail and the surrounding area:

- Upper Rouge Trail and Antelope Drive are located north of Sheppard Avenue East and east of Morningside Avenue.
- Upper Rouge Trail and Antelope Drive are two-lane local roads with pavement widths of approximately 8.5 metres.
- The land use on Upper Rouge Trail and on Antelope Drive consists of single family residential dwellings.
- Sidewalks are located on at least one side of Upper Rouge Trail and on Antelope Drive.

The proposed technical amendments to the time period of the stopping regulations on Upper Rouge Trail and on Antelope Drive will be consistent with the signs that have already been installed.
