

Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments, and Draft Plan of Subdivision Appeal: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City Clerk, attention: Yvonne Davies, Administrator, Scarborough Community Council, at the address, fax number or e-mail set out in this notice before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted or refused, Zoning By-law Amendment is passed or refused, Plan of Subdivision is approved or refused, the person or

public body is not entitled to appeal the decision to the Ontario Municipal Board and may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
