SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend Council Member appointments to City Council.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. Striking Committee consider Members' preferences and recommend to City Council the names of Council Members to be appointed to the committees, agencies and external bodies listed in Attachment 1 for a term of office until December 31, 2016 and until successors are appointed, under Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, unless Attachment 1 notes otherwise.
2. City Council appoint Ward Councillors to the community-based boards listed in Attachment 2 for a term of office until November 30, 2018 and until successors are appointed unless Attachment 2 notes otherwise.
3. City Council authorize the City Solicitor to introduce any necessary bills to give effect to Council's appointments.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

This report has no financial impact.

DECISION HISTORY

City Council appoints Council Members to committees, agencies and external bodies at the start and mid-point of each Council term. Council's procedures set the term of most Council Member appointments at half of Council's term (two years) unless a law or the appointment states otherwise.

COMMENTS

The City Clerk has canvassed Members-elect for their interest in appointments to committees, agencies and external bodies. Their responses have been summarized in Attachment 1. Community-based boards to which the Ward Councillor is generally appointed for the term of Council are listed in Attachment 2.
