Realignment of Permit Parking Area "3K" to exclude 1093 Queen Street West

SUMMARY

Transportation Services is requesting approval from City Council to amend the boundary of permit parking area 3K.

Transportation Services has assessed the realignment of permit parking area 3K to exclude the property located at 1093 Queen Street West as requested by Toronto and East York Community Council on May 5, 2015. We are recommending approval of the realignment as it will not impact negatively on the Permit Parking Area.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that:

1. City Council approve the amendment to Schedule B of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate a revised map of permit parking area "3K", as attached in Appendix "A" of the report (August 10, 2015) from the Manager, Right of Way Management, Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with this report.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

City Council at its meeting of May 5, 2015 in considering a Motion by Councillor Ana Bailao, requested Transportation Services to examine and report back to Toronto and East York Community Council on September 1, 2015 regarding the realignment of parking area 3K and the exclusion of the subject site 1093 Queen Street East from the Permit Parking area.

COMMENTS

Permit Parking area 3K is bounded by Dundas Street West, Ossington Avenue, Queen Street West, the west end of Shaw Street, CN Railway and Dufferin Street. Area 3K has 885 on-street parking spaces. To date, 810 permits have been issued. This area does not have a history of being waitlisted, meaning the demand for overnight on-street parking permits has never exceeded the supply of parking spaces. There is TTC service on Queen Street West. The Councillor and residents neighbouring 1093 Queen Street West support this action as a means of ensuring that this new development does not negatively impact the Permit Parking supply to the existing neighbourhood.

Transportation Services has no objection to the exclusion of 1093 Queen Street West from permit parking area "3K".
