Its finally happening! Sir John A. MacDonald Plaza at Union Station is nearly done construction and will be opening its newly expanded approximately 10,000SQFT outdoor space. As this is the first part of Toronto that many visitors will see, the facility and partners have created an event that is welcoming for all and highlights the diverse and spectacular food culture of the City.

We are writing about the first annual Union Summer featuring Front Street Foods that will bring to life a wide-ranging food market showcasing Toronto's best chefs, restaurants, bakers, food entrepreneurs, and artisanal food makers. The food vendors and seating areas will be located such they do not interfere with pedestrian traffic flows but are easily visible and accessible by all.

Vendors who are new to the food scene or famous chefs are equally welcome. The Market intends to represent and showcase the best of Toronto! It is unique in Toronto because it highlights the diverse food culture in the City, encourages and supports food related entrepreneurship and offers attendees an unparalleled opportunity to explore and discover food creations. Given the highly visible and highly trafficked location of the event it will be a rich environment for both economic and cultural growth.

To ensure that our event runs smoothly and efficiently for all parties involved, we will be providing private security and lots of staff to help manage the event. Our management team is supported by experienced and well-trained event staff. Our team is well versed in contingency plans, which we work on diligently with all of our partners, including Front Street Foods at Union Summer, Toronto Market Company and the stakeholders at Union Station. Safety is paramount and our security company will make sure that we have a member with paramedic training.
