I am writing to inform you of an event that will take place in and around Daniels Spectrum, the cultural centre at 585 Dundas Street East in Toronto. The Pan American Food Festival presents the best cuisine and culture of the Americas, featuring international chefs, free food demonstrations musical performances and more, in a lively street fair. Returning for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year, the Festival takes place August 1 to 3, 2015.

We would like to create a licensed area serving beer and alcoholic beverages outdoors on the fenced-in terrace attached to the Daniels Spectrum building over the 3 days of the Festival. The space will be called the Cancun Patio and will operate from noon to 11pm on August 1 and 2, and noon to 7pm on August. The Patio has a capacity of 80 people. The proceeds from the sales will support the operations of the Pan American Food Festival, presented by ArtsXplosion Cultural Society, a non-profit corporation registered in Ontario in 2012.

We have applied for a Special Occasion Permit and are also informing the police and fire departments, as well as Toronto Public Health. More information on the Festival can be found at www.panamfoodfest.com
