Dear Mayor Tory and other Members of the Council:

I write in my capacity as President of the Ossington Community Association<sup>1</sup> (OCA) concerning the proposed cuts to Canada Post home delivery.

We have serious concerns regarding the placement of Canada Post Community Mail Boxes.

- Home mail delivery an important service, which makes sense in a densely populated urban area such as Toronto.
- Cutting home main delivery will be inconvenient, especially for elderly or disabled persons.
- Moreover, the large community mail boxes are an eyesore, which use up alreadyscarce public space.
- Finally, there is no cost-based justification for cutting this service: Canada Post made a large profit last year:
