Dear Council Members,

Downtown Yonge BIA continues to provide exciting urban experiences through events within its footprint. These events attract local and out-of-town visitors and create a more vibrant downtown. Below are two of our annual events that are part of Winter Magic:

Illuminite, this event kicks off the holiday season in the neighbourhood. The event provides audience a 360 degree theatrical experience in the heart of Downtown – Yonge Dundas Square. Illuminite will be on Saturday, November 14, 2015.

Ice, Wine & Dine is a culinary event showcasing the restaurants on the historic Elm Street (between Yonge and Bay). This will be on November 21, 2015.

On behalf of Downtown Yonge BIA and our members, I am writing to request that you present the following resolution at City Council, as required by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario:

- A resolution that classifies Illuminite and Ice, Wine and Dine as an event of municipal and/or community significance. Details:

 - o Ice, Wine and Dine, November 21, 2015 from 3pm to midnight.
- A resolution that allows Toronto Eaton Chelsea as part of Ice, Wine & Dine to extend their patio
 outside the hotel's Elm Street Entrance during the event.
