77-79 East Don Roadway and 661 – 677 Queen Street East Zoning Amendment Applications – Final Report

We are the owner of the buildings located at 100 Broadview Avenue (Hullmark (100 Broadview) Ltd.) and 635 Queen Street East (Hullmark (635 Queen) Ltd.).

The applicant has been very proactive in communicating the evolution of their development applications over the past couple of years. We have reviewed the final staff report under consideration by City Council and we are in support of the plan. We believe that the proposed development is a very sensitive mixed use scheme that will integrate into the current contextual fabric very well. In addition, it proposes many community benefits that will contribute to Riverside's continued prosperity.

We have been consulting with the applicant with respect to some proximity acoustic concerns that we have with residential uses next to our mechanical rooms and rooftop equipment. We are confident that we will be able to work through the technical mitigation requirements through the Site Plan process and construction document phase with the applicant. However, in order to protect our long term interests and binding future owners we respectfully request that the City incorporate any agreed to mitigation measure into the Site Plan Drawings and Agreement. It is our understanding that the Site Plan applications have not been submitted to the City yet and that there is ample opportunity for incorporation.

We request that we be notified of any future applications.
