REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

COMMENTS

Composition of the board

The board consists of 6 members and is composed of:

- the General Manager of Parks, Forestry and Recreation of the City of Toronto or his or her designate, as chair of the board
- the Chief Corporate Officer of the City of Toronto or his or her designate
- the Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer of the City of Toronto or his or her designate
- a representative of the tenants of the corporation, and approved by the shareholder
- 2 members of the public

Board positions to be appointed

The Corporations Nominating Panel will recommend two candidates to serve as public members, and one candidate to serve as a tenant representative.

Board members should meet certain qualifications

In addition to the requirements outlined in the Public Appointments Policy, public members appointed to the board should collectively represent a range of expertise in:

- sports and entertainment
- finance
- marketing

Public members will serve two-year terms and until successors are appointed

Public members will be appointed for a term of office until June 7, 2018, continuing to serve until successors are appointed.

Public release of names of recommended candidates

The name of the recommended candidates will be publicly reported once the Corporations Nominating Panel forwards its recommendations to City Council.
