5. Temporary liquor licence extensions until 4:00 a.m., for the following venues during the 30th Annual TD Toronto Jazz Festival, to be held from June 24 to July 3, 2016:

The Painted Lady is confirmed, plus  
The Rex Jazz and Blues Bar, 194 Queen Street West  
Fat City Blues, 890 College Street  
Reposado Bar and Lounge, 136 Ossington Avenue

"The TEYCC advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection, for liquor licensing purposes, to a temporary liquor licence extension until 4:00am for The Paddock Tavern at 178 Bathurst St, during the 30th Annual TD Toronto Jazz Festival, to be held from June 24 to July 3, 2016."
