
### Duties of the Integrity Commissioner



- Direct stakeholders
  - 45 members of Council
  - All appointees to approximately 100 Local Boards (approximately 1000 people)
- Mandatory Duties
  - Confidential advice to individual members of Council or Local Boards about compliance with standards of conduct.
  - Investigations into allegations that standards of conduct have not been met.
  - Education and outreach to all entities within jurisdiction.
  - Policy advice to City Council as a whole or Local Boards on issues of ethics and integrity.






### Work of the Office – Formal Complaints





### Work of the office – Outreach and Policy



- Education and Outreach
  - Meetings and presentations with staff, councillors, local boards, external groups. (2014: 18 initiatives.)
  - Code of Conduct Training for BIAs and Adjudicative Boards.
- Policy activities or initiatives, such as:
  - Use of social media policy.
  - Participation in the Provincial Government's municipal legislation review and in City Council review of Accountability Officers.
  - Review and update gift disclosure procedures and establish gift registry on the OIC website.
  - Records and information management policies internal to OIC.

#### Request overview



- Total proposed budget for 2016: \$793.3 thousand
  - Base budget pressures of \$51.4 thousand
  - Enhancements of \$314.1 thousand
- Enhancements:
  - Contingency funding for external investigative and legal support (\$150 thousand).
  - One (1) new position Outreach Coordinator (\$82.7 thousand) and one-time setup cost for office configuration/moving expenses (\$81.4 thousand).
- Request is 0.008% of the City's 2016 Preliminary Budget of \$10.036 Billion.
  - Without enhancements the request is 0.005% of the City's 2016 Preliminary Budget.

### Why are more resources needed?



- Ensure stakeholders receive timely advice and completion of investigations.
  - OIC is still working to clear backlog of complaints from prior term and has continued to receive same volume of new complaints.
  - These kinds of disputes call out for timely and quick resolution.
- Enable IC to obtain legal advice and investigation support when necessary.
  - OIC has no internal legal advisor.
- Enable OIC to fulfill outreach duties efficiently and strategically.
  - Address awareness gap among Local Boards.
  - Develop resources for Local Boards.
  - Develop strategies and maximize online tools to improve all methods of outreach.

## Key Request: External Support



- The 2016 Base Budget includes only \$10,350 for outside legal support.
- For both 2014 and 2015, OIC exceeded its budget for outside legal support budget due to complex cases, MFIPPA issues, judicial review and required investigation support.

 OIC requests that the Budget Committee prioritize the request for an external support budget (\$150 thousand).
